In the past two years, NEH has added the Standing Together initiative to its already critical work. The initiative funds reading groups for veterans that help them process their experiences through discussions of literature on war and homecoming; writing programs for veterans suffering from PTSD; intensive college-preparation programs; and training for Veterans Affairs staff to help them understand the experiences of veterans.

In addition to this initiative, NEH continues to support the work of humanities councils like our award-winning New Hampshire Humanities – all independent nonprofits in every state and territory – as well as museums, libraries, and universities to preserve and explore local history and traditions; promote understanding among diverse communities; and foster a sense of our common ideals, enduring civic values, and shared cultural heritage.

NEH funding of New Hampshire Humanities provides critical leverage that annually results in programming and grants that reach more than 70,000 NH residents in more than 170 cities and towns in partnership with more than 300 local organizations.
